We have focused our attention on enhancing routine cleaning in preparation, and social distancing practices with more proactive and preventative measures in place. We remain committed to upholding the highest standards of cleanliness and have taken an extra level of sanitary precautions so you can feel at ease during your stay. The below effective response measures are helping us continue to provide a safe and clean environment for all:

- Comprehensive COVID-19 guidance is in place, including providing hand sanitizers and frequent cleaning of high-touch areas.

Enhanced Environmental Cleaning and Social Distancing Practices

- Designated employee to focus on sanitizing, which includes routinely cleaning all frequently touched surfaces throughout the inn
- Disposable wipes so that commonly used surfaces (for example, doorknobs, handrails, tables) can be wiped down and disinfected by employees throughout the day
- Hand sanitizer in all public areas and at check-in
- Increased cleaning of restrooms and public areas, and providing housekeeping service upon request or at checkout
- We are not allowing more than 10 guests in the Inn at any time and only utilizing rooms downstairs to allow comfortable spacing
- We will continue offering the Cottage and Cabin as they are outside spaces
- We are not serving refreshments in our common areas but putting snacks in the rooms
- Our breakfast is continental only and we are setting it up so it is delivered to the rooms
- However, we do have a large dining area so it is possible to keep social distancing if needed
- We are postponing all scheduled dinners until at least April 3. We will update our schedule when possible.
